- If the second thought contrasts the first, it is **ANTITHETICAL** parallelism.
- Life experiences can show us what we **<u>DON'T</u>** want through seeing what we **<u>DO</u>** want.

If the second and third add to the first, it is		
STAIRLIKE parallelism.
